Now Saul, still breathing threats and murder against the Disciples of the Lord, went to the High Priest (Caiaphas), and asked for Letters (Warrants Of Authority, Legal Arrest & Extradition) from him to the Synagogues at Damascus, so that if he found any belonging to the "Way", both men and women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem. As Saul was traveling, it happened that he was approaching Damascus, and suddenly a Light from Heaven flashed around him; and he fell to the ground and heard a Voice saying to him, "Saul! Saul! Why are You Persecuting Me?" And Saul inquired, "Who Are You, Lord?" And the Lord said, "I AM Jesus Whom You are Persecuting, Is it hard for you to kick against Me?" The men who traveled with Saul stood speechless, hearing the Voice but seeing no one. Saul got up from the ground, and though his eyes were open, he could see nothing; and leading him by the hand, the men brought him into Damascus. And Saul was three days without sight, and neither ate nor drank (Fasting & Praying). Acts 9:1-9 (NKJV)

Saul Was A Gentile/Jew From Birth Like Many In The Hellenistic World. This Combined Genealogy Allowed Him Access To Both The Freedman Synagogue (Gentile/Jewish Converts) - Acts 6:8-14 & The Main Temple (Jewish Born Believers) - Acts 6:15

Saul Was A "Jewish Praeco"

A Proclaimer Of The Trial Sentence Pronounced With Councilor Authority Of The Sanhedrin "And the witnesses laid down their clothes at the feet of a young man named Saul." ... "Now Saul was consenting to Stephen's death." ... Acts 7:58b & 8:1a

Saul Was A "Jewish Procurator"

An Agent Representing The Jewish Council In Both Jewish & Roman Courts of Law In The Countries Under Roman Civil Law & Rule

"At that time, a great persecution arose against the Church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all <u>scattered</u> (*diaspora*) throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles."... "As for <u>Saul</u>, he made havoc of the church, entering every house, and dragging off men and women, committing them to prison!" Acts 8:1b & 3

New Severe Form Of Persecution Against His People?"

"Did Saul (Paul) Ever Look Back Later In His New Life In Christ And Reflect About His Sinful Condition, His Attitude, & Spirit Toward Others, Especially Christians?"

# A – Yes, He Did!

Paul Later In Chains For His Witness To Christ Testified To King Agrippa In Caesarea Philippi! "Indeed, I myself thought I must do many things contrary to the Name of Jesus of Nazareth. This I also did in Jerusalem, and many of the Saints I shut up in prison, having received authority from the chief priests; and when they were put to death, I cast my vote against them. <u>And I punished them often</u> in every synagogue and compelled them to blaspheme; <u>and being</u> <u>exceedingly enraged against them</u>, <u>I persecuted them</u> even to foreign cities."

Acts 26:9-11 (NKJV)

#### A – Yes, He Did!

#### Paul Later Reflected In His 1<sup>st</sup> Epistle - Letter To Timothy!

"And I Thank Christ Jesus Our Lord who has enabled me, because He counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry, although I was formerly a blasphemer, a persecutor, and an insolent man; but I obtained mercy because I did it ignorantly in unbelief. And the Grace of Our Lord was exceedingly abundant, with faith and love which are in Christ Jesus. This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of Whom I am Chief (Among All Sinners). However, for this reason I obtained mercy, that in me, first Jesus Christ might show all longsuffering, as a pattern to those who are going to believe on Him for everlasting life."

Let's Go Back To God's Direct Intervention In The Life Of Saul Of Tarsus! As Saul was traveling, it happened that he was approaching Damascus, and suddenly a *Light from Heaven* flashed around him; and he fell to the ground and heard a Voice saying to him, "Saul! Saul! Why are You Persecuting Me?" Acts 9:3-4

"What Did Saul Recognize In His Blindness Both Physically & Mentally?"

That The Voice Speaking To Him Was Indeed God, As God's Spirit Suddenly Awakened Saul's Spirit By Direct Divine Revelation! And Saul inquired, "Who Are You, Lord?"

Immediately God Responds Audibly & Visually In Person (Epiphany & Theophany)! And the Lord said, "I AM Jesus Whom You are Persecuting, Is it hard for you to kick against Me?"

#### Q

"What Happened To Saul In This Instant Direct Divine Personal Awakening?"

Paul Later Describes Exactly What He Suddenly Understood:

His Intellect Was Enlightened, His Unbelief Was Changed To Faith, He Laid Down His Will,

His Evil Actions Were Halted & Changed, & The Thoughts Of His Heart Were All Changed,

In An Instant Moment In Time!

After Some Inward Reflection, Paul Describes His Glorious Conversion Experience To The Church In Corinth!

"Therefore, since we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we do not lose heart. But we have renounced the hidden things of shame, not walking in craftiness nor handling the Word of God deceitfully, but by Manifestation of the Truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the Sight of God. But even if our Gospel Is Veiled, It Is Veiled to those who are perishing, whose minds the god of this age (Satan) has blinded, who do not believe, lest the Light of the Gospel of the Glory of Christ, Who Is the Very Image of God, should Shine on them. For we do not preach ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord, and ourselves your bondservants for Jesus' Sake. For it is the God Who Commanded Light to Shine Out of Darkness, Who has Shone in Our Hearts to Give the Light of the Knowledge of the Glory of God in the Face of Jesus Christ!" 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 4:1-6 (NKJV)

"What Was Paul's Immediate Response To God's Intervention In The Person Of Jesus Christ?"

Saul Immediately Is Humbled & Obediently Asking God's Will In His Life!

So, Saul trembling and astonished, said, "Lord, what do You want me to do?"

Then the Lord said to him,

"Arise and go into the City (Damascus), and you will be told what you must do!"

### Acts 9:6

"Was This Miraculous Intervention Of Signs & Wonders On The Road To Damascus Confirmed By Anyone Other Than Saul?" A – Yes!

The men who traveled with Saul stood speechless, hearing the Voice but seeing no one.

#### Acts 9:7 NOTE!

Now, this is indeed important information, for even the unbelievers in Jesus Christ the Lord, the soldiers with Saul, also are witnesses to the Divine Intervention from Heaven! For many modern skeptics often say Paul mad this whole event up. But when these soldiers were in Damascus, they stirred up the people against Saul to kill him, and later after returning to Jerusalem they witness to the High Priest and Sanhedrin Council. The proof of these events is that now Saul (Paul) is hunted by the Jewish Religious Authorities as well (Acts 21).
