Acts 14:24-28

And after They (Paul & Barnabas) \*[began to make their return <sup>a</sup> trip],\* They passed through Pisidian (Antioch),<sup>1</sup> then They came to Pamphylia. <sup>2</sup> Now when They had Preached the Word (Gospel) in Perga, <sup>3</sup> They went down to Attalia. <sup>4</sup> From there They sailed to Antioch, <sup>5</sup> where They had been <u>Commended</u> to the <u>Grace of God</u> for the <u>Work</u> (Preaching & Teaching) which They had completed. Now when They (Paul & Barnabas) had come and gathered the Church (Antioch) <sup>5</sup> together, They reported <sup>b</sup> all that God had done with Them, and that He (God) had opened the <u>Door of Faith</u> to the Gentiles. So, They stayed there a long-time <sup>c & d</sup> with the Disciples.

Paul Enters The Local Synagogue & Awaits An Opportunity To Preach / Teach / Debate NOTE Paul Always Uses A 4-Part Formula When Sharing The Gospel of Good News 1) OT Kerygma Central Story of Deliverance & Salvation of God's People According To God's Plan & Promise 2) NT Kerygma Central Story of Deliverance & Salvation of God's People Fulfilled In Jesus Christ 3) Support With Various Scriptures Use The Scriptures Read In The Synagogue / Church Meeting That Day &/Or Use Supporting Scriptures From The Bible 4) Exhort & Encourage The Audience To Go Further In Their Thinking & Understanding Of The Past & Their Lives "What Is The Plan God Desires His True Followers To Follow Whenever He Opens A Spiritual Door Or Sets Up A Spiritual Encounter?" Believers/Followers Of Jesus Christ Are To Be Bold In His Spirit & Ready To Enact An Initial 4-Fold Plan: 1) Presentation, 2) Decision, 3) Judgement, & 4) Movement "What Is The Plan God Desires Of His True Followers To Follow Whenever They Make Rencounter Or Pay A Follow Up Visit To Those They Have Already Presented The Gospel Message To?" Believers/Followers Of Jesus Christ Are To Be Bold In His Spirit & Ready To Enact A Follow-Up 4-Fold Plan: 1) Report/Presentation, 2) Encourage/Decision, 3) Commission/Ordain, & 4) Equip/Mentor Let's Take A Look At Paul & Barnabas' Return Trip And when They (Paul & Barnabas) had preached the Gospel to the city (of Derbe) and made many Disciples, They returned to Lystra, Iconium, and (Pisidian) Antioch, strengthening the Souls of the Disciples, exhorting Them to continue in the faith, and saying (rhema / prophecy), "We must through many tribulations enter the Kingdom of God!" So, when They (Paul & Barnabas) had appointed (commissioned & ordained) Elders in every Church, and prayed with fasting, They (Paul & Barnabas) commended Them (Disciples) to the Lord in Whom

They had believed (by faith).
