

“Jesus Christ - Eternal High Priest of God”
Book of Hebrews

Hebrews	Scripture
2:17	Therefore, in all things <u>He</u> had to be made like <u>His</u> brethren, that <u>He</u> might be a merciful & faithful <u>High Priest</u> in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.
3:1	Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the <u>Apostle</u> and <u>High Priest</u> of our confession, <u>Christ Jesus</u> !
4:14	Seeing then that we have a great <u>High Priest</u> who has passed through the heavens, <u>Jesus the Son of God</u> , let us hold fast our confession.
4:15	For we do not have a <u>High Priest</u> who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.
5:5	So also, <u>Christ</u> did not glorify <u>Himself</u> to become <u>High Priest</u> , but it was <u>He</u> Who said to <u>Him</u> : “ <u>You</u> are <u>My Son</u> , Today <u>I</u> have begotten <u>You</u> .”
5:10	Called by <u>God</u> as <u>High Priest</u> “according to the order of <u>Melchizedek</u> !”
6:20	Where the <u>Forerunner</u> has entered for us, even <u>Jesus</u> , having become <u>High Priest</u> forever according to the order of <u>Melchizedek</u> .
7:1	For this <u>Melchizedek</u> , <u>King</u> of Salem, <u>Priest</u> of the <u>Most High God</u> , <u>Who</u> met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings & blessed him.
7:26	For such a <u>High Priest</u> was fitting for us, <u>Who</u> is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, & has become higher than the heavens.
7:27	<u>Who</u> does not need daily, as those <u>high priests</u> , to offer up sacrifices, first for <u>His</u> own sins & then for the people’s, for this <u>He</u> did once for all when <u>He</u> offered up <u>Himself</u> .
7:28	For the law appoints as <u>high priests</u> men who have weakness, but the word of the oath, which came after the law, appoints the <u>Son</u> who has been perfected forever.
8:1	Now this is the main point of the things we are saying: We have such a <u>High Priest</u> , <u>Who</u> is seated at the right hand of the throne of the majesty in the heavens.
8:3	For every <u>high priest</u> is appointed to offer both gifts & sacrifices. Therefore, it is necessary that this <u>One</u> also have something to offer.
9:11	But <u>Christ</u> came as <u>High Priest</u> of the good things to come, with the greater & more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation.
9:25	Not that <u>He</u> should offer <u>Himself</u> often, as the <u>high priest</u> enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood of another.
10:10-12	By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the <u>Body of Jesus Christ</u> <u>once for all</u> . And every <u>priest</u> stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. But this <u>Man</u> , after <u>He</u> had Offered <u>One Sacrifice for Sins Forever</u> , sat down at the Right Hand of God.
10:21	And having a <u>High Priest</u> over the House of <u>God</u> .
